The following states require Bow hunter Ed certification: Alaska*, Arizona*, Colorado*, Connecticut, Idaho, Iowa*, Louisiana*, Maine, Minnesota*, Missouri*, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York*, Ohio*, Pennsylvania*, Rhode Island, South Dakota*, Texas*, Utah*, Vermont.

Please Note: This class does NOT satisfy the Missouri Hunter Ed requirement for firearms permits and licenses. Bowhunter Ed Certification is not mandatory in Missouri.
